RUSSIAN WHEAT AHIPIID - NEW RESTRICTIONS FOR MACHINERY

In response to the detection of the serious agricultural pest 'Russian Wheat Aphid' (RWA) in regions of South Australia and Victoria, the Department of Agriculture and Food, Western Australia (DAFWA) has implemented the following restriction on the movement of machinery into WA.

Effective as of the 22nd June 2016 the entry of machinery (or parts thereof), that is designed to be used on or likely to come in contact with plant material, is prohibited entry into Western Australia unless accompanied by a statutory declaration, completed by the exporter, describing the machinery and stating that the machinery (or parts thereof) "has not been used in a state or territory where Russian Wheat Aphid has been detected, in the 30 days prior to entry into Western Australia".

Therefore a complying statutory declaration must be provided to the relevant Quarantine WA Office for the point of entry, to enable any affected machinery to proceed past that point.
